All pet/companion puppies are sold on limited AKC registration and on a spay/neuter contract. All show/breeding quality puppies are sold on full AKC registration and on a co-ownership agreement and contract, with Rebecca Lane as co-owner.

I am a member in good standing of the Pembroke Welsh Corgis Club of America, the Golden Gate Pembroke Welsh Corgi Fanciers and the Cardigan Welsh Corgi Club of America.

The parents of the puppies have been tested and evaluated for Hip Dysplasia, Von Willebrand's Disease (vWD) in Pembrokes, Degenerative Myelopathy (DM) and have had their eyes checked and cleared by CERF. The puppies will have their eyes examined at 8 weeks old, will be current on their vaccinations, will have been wormed, started on heartworm prevention and, on request, will be tested for DM.

All of my puppies are born and raised in my home. I hold a minimum of 2 puppy socialization parties for every litter (generally at 5 and 8 weeks old), start leash and crate training and get them used to having their toenails done with a Dremel.

I will very carefully evaluate all of my available puppies and will consider each family's wishes when matching each puppy to their new family. I will not guarantee anyone a puppy until after the entire litter has gone through an extensive structural evaluation at 8 - 9 weeks old. All prospective new families are more than welcome to come and visit, after the puppies are at least 4 - 5 weeks old. I encourage you to attend at least one of the puppy parties, if possible.

The current price for one my puppies is \$1000 for pet/companion puppies, with limited registration and with a spay/neuter agreement, and \$1200 for show/breeding prospects, with full registration and a co-ownership agreement.
